Guest Moorage and fuel sales were strong this past season. To date, we've had the pleasure of 26 yacht club visits with more scheduled through the end of the year.

To better serve you and our future customers we have remodeled the Marina office, and are excited to welcome Tara Reilly as our new Office Specialist.

We have started to make some much needed improvements to enhance the Marina for all our customers.

1. We have updated a few of our Dry Sheds, starting with some new doors and paint.
2. New tenant garbage enclosures are planned to be installed on the 29<sup>th</sup> of Oct.
3. We are to start the process for the new tenant restroom project in 2019 but in the interim we will be doing some cosmetic improvements on the current ones (i.e. lighting, paint, Etc.). We anticipate and are looking forward to many discussions/meetings for input.
4. Staff has ordered 75 safety ladders, and with the help from DMMA these ladders will be installed throughout both permanent and guest moorage.
5. The new activity tent expansion has arrived and staff hopes to have that up soon, thus allowing larger club visits. Also having the ability to split the tent will allow us to accommodate multiple clubs, or other type of future events and rental opportunities.
