Harbor Master Report is available on the Marina website.

The bulkhead project is still on track, they have completed the sheet-pile seawall all the way around the North Parking lot. I will ask Project Manager Khai Le to join us in March for an update on what we should expect moving forward into the summer months.

The Fuel upgrade project is complete, we are up and running. 😊

Still working on the Entrance Green Buoy, along with coordination with the Army Core of Engineers for future deployment.

For the Marina landside development, the City and the development team are close to finalizing the exclusive negotiation agreement.

No new update to report on the Tenant restroom.

“A” Dock ramp replacement: we are shooting for swapping it late this month, or early next month, we should be able to do everything involved in a day. At the same time we will utilize the Crane service to do a ramp connection fix on “J” Dock.

At the February 10th Council meeting (tomorrow night), the Chief Operations Officer will be providing the City Council an update on the economic, financial, and design alternatives analysis for dock replacements, along with next steps for replacement of L, M, and N docks. I encourage those interested to watch the Council meeting on line.
