I have yet to receive any correspondence from the Army Core of Engineers about assistance with placement of the Green Buoy, so at this point, we have hired a diver (3/7/2022) to locate the anchor and see what is needed to get this fixed and reattach.

For the Marina landside development, the City and the development team are continuing their efforts on the exclusive negotiation agreement. We should have an update at a future Council meeting.

"A" Dock ramp replacement: We have scheduled the Crane Company to be here on March 16th. There will be some impacts to "A" Dock access, during this day. We will get that information posted on the gate and Website.

At last month's City Council meeting Dan Brewer, the Cities Chief Operations Officer provided an update and presentation on the Marina's Waterside Development. This information has been posted on our Marina's Web site.

At tomorrow's March 10th City Council meeting, Chief Operations Officer Dan Brewer will be providing a presentation on the Marina Enterprise Department.
