The following are the updates we have for May.

Jim Arnold of Alpha Marine is just waiting for a favorable weather window to install the Helix anchor needed to re-install the Green Entrance Buoy.

I anticipate the South Sound Opening day as being a huge success.

I have reached back out to the Tenant Restroom team; I hope to have more information in an upcoming presentation. As I stated last meeting, I dropped the ball on this one. With rising costs in design, materials and construction, the City's general fund is contributing an extra \$400,000 of ARPA funds to this project.

As for the Marina landside development, the City and the development team are continuing their efforts on the exclusive negotiation agreement.

We are ongoing in our efforts in working with our consultants in composing the letters to Marina Tenants on L-N, including customers on our waiting lists for those slip sizes. I anticipate having something to share in June's report.
